1. Types of information collected

We collect the following information:

- Personal, identifying and non-sensitive data (for example, but not limited to, name, surname, address, telephone number, e-mail address hereinafter, "personal data" or even "data") communicated by you in order to request information or make a reservation
- **Non-personal data.** Like most websites, we gather statistical and other analytical information on an aggregate basis of all visitors to our websites. This Non-Personal Data comprises information that cannot be used to identify or contact you, such as user IP addresses, browser and operating system types and other anonymous statistical data involving the use of our websites (for further info, please refer to the Cookies section below).

2. Purposes for which we hold and process your information and legal basis

- prevent or discover fraudulent activities or malicious activities harmful to the websites;
- exercise the rights of the Data Controller, for example the right to exercise a right in court;
- we use the Non-Personal Data gathered from visitors to our websites in an aggregate form to get a better understanding of where our visitors come from and to help us better design and organize our websites, products and services.
- 1. B) Only subject to your specific and distinct consent (articles 23 and 130 of the Privacy Code and article 7 of the GDPR), for the following Other Purposes:

3. Processing methods and retention period

Your personal data are processed either on paper or electronically. Data processed electronically are stored locally – e.g. on personal computer – (data contained in invoices/receipts) and in a secure cloud-based Property Management System, managed by Adra Systems s.r.l., with registered office at 24, Piazza del Popolo, 20025 Legnano (MI), Italy.

By law we have to keep basic information about guests (e.g. those contained in invoices or receipts) for a minimum of 10 years for tax purposes.

Data relating to information/quote requests will be retained until the date such requests refer to, and, in any case, for a maximum of 1 vear

4. Security of your personal data

We place great importance on the security of all personally identifiable information associated with our customers. We use technical security measures to prevent the loss, misuse, alteration or unauthorized disclosure of information under our control. We use security measures including and not limited to: physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online. We do not collect sensitive information.

Online Payment Processing

We use the Secureholiday.net platform as our partner for booking and payment processing. Secureholiday.net is managed by the French Company Ctoutvert Sarl, with registered office at 10, Place Alfonse Jourdain, F-31000 Toulouse. This platform uses the most secure up to date encrypted SSL (secure socket layer) when transferring transaction details of your online booking. This means that no information submitted during this process can be examined, used or modified by any unauthorized third parties. SSL Certificate

Our website utilizes Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) technology to allow for the encryption of information passed between your computer and our website, so that it cannot be read in the event someone else intercepts it.

5. Access to data

Your data may be made accessible for the purposes referred to in art. 2.A) and 2.B):

- to employees and collaborators of the Data Controller, in their capacity as persons in charge and / or internal managers of the processing and / or system administrators;
- to third-party companies or other subjects (web site provider, cloud provider, e-payment service provider, suppliers, hardware and software service engineers, credit institutes, professional offices, etc.) that perform outsourcing activities on behalf of the Data Controller, in their capacity as data controllers.

6. Cross-border Data transfer

When we share your personal information with our partners and service providers, your personal information may be transferred to and/or made accessible from countries out of the European Economic Area. In such circumstances, processing of your data is authorized based on specific decisions of the European Union and of the Italian Data Protection Agency (Garante per la tutela dei dati personali), in particular Decision no. 1250/2016 (Privacy Shield); no specific consent is therefore required.

7. Nature of providing data and consequences of refusing to answer

The provision of data for the purposes referred to in art. 2.A) is mandatory. In their absence, we cannot guarantee you neither the registration to the Site nor the services of the art. 2.A).

The provision of data for the purposes referred to in art. 2.B) is optional. You can therefore decide not to give any data or to subsequently deny the possibility of processing data already provided: in this case, you cannot receive e-mail invitations to events, newsletters. In any case, you will continue to be entitled to the Services referred to in art. 2.A).

9. Rights of the interested party

In your capacity as interested parties, you have the rights set forth in art. 7 of the Privacy Code and art. 15 GDPR and precisely the rights of:

- ii. obtain the indication: a) of the origin of personal data; b) of the purposes and methods of the processing; c) of the logic applied in case of treatment carried out with the aid of electronic instruments; d) of the identification details of the owner, the managers and the designated representative pursuant to art. 5, paragraph 2 of the Privacy Code and art. 3, paragraph 1, GDPR; e) the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of it in their capacity as designated representative in the territory of the State, managers or agents;

- iii. obtain: a) updating, rectification or, when interested, integration of data; b) the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed; c) the attestation that the operations referred to in letters a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case where this fulfillment is it proves impossible or involves a use of means manifestly disproportionate to the protected right;
- iv. to object, in whole or in part: a) for legitimate reasons, to the processing of personal data concerning you, even if pertinent to the purpose of the collection; b) to the processing of personal data concerning you for the purpose of sending advertising or direct sales material or for carrying out market research or commercial communication, through the use of automated call systems without the intervention of an operator by e-mail and / or through traditional marketing methods by telephone and / or paper mail. It should be noted that the right of opposition of the interested party, set out in point b) above, for direct marketing purposes through automated methods extends to traditional ones and that in any case the possibility remains for the data subject to exercise the right to object even only partially. Therefore, the interested party can decide to receive only communications using traditional methods or only automated communications or none of the two types of communication.

Where applicable, you also have the rights referred to in Articles 16-21 GDPR (Right of rectification, right to be forgotten, right of limitation of treatment, right to data portability, right of opposition), as well as the right of complaint to the Guarantor Authority.
